Developmental Benefits of Play: Communicative, Physical, Creative, Cognitive, Social, Emotional



Focus Skills/Subject: Observation, Speaking, Vocabulary, Comprehension, Storytelling, Imagination, Inference, Research

Grades: K-4

Have the students explore different towers from around the world, and discuss what a tower is and why we have them.
