Grades: PreK – 1

- Write out the alphabet on pieces of paper. It can be uppercase, lowercase or both.
- Create two lines of students to play against each other. To keep the competition fair, pair the students based on how advanced they are with the alphabet.
- Flash the cards at the students, and whoever states what letter is being shown first wins!
